



Due to the fact that the biodiesel market has been evolving for many years now in Germany, numerous examples could be given for the active players along the entire biodiesel chain: the range would embrace biomass producers, processing companies, factory technology providers and biodiesel dealers with all of the corresponding associations as well as research groups, policy-makers and controlling bodies. However, such a complete list of all active players would be extremely long and probably too detailed for the general public. Therefore, Table 1 gives an overview over selected central market players, policy-making and controlling bodies as well as research institutions which are among the most relevant in connection with the entire biodiesel chain in Germany.
