WP8. Handbook and Booklet for Kenaf

The results of the proposed RTD project will be documented in a handbook on kenaf. This handbook will include:

- The valuable information on kenaf that will be gathered and evaluated in the framework of the project.
- The relevant updated literature covering the production aspects and stages of the crop as well as all the possible end-uses (energy production, fiber production, paper and pulp production, forage production, etc.). An important role during handbook preparation will play the literature review for kenaf, carried out by the partner 1 at the beginning of the project.



Contents of the handbook

- 1. Background and Taxonomy of the crop (origin of the genus, presentation of all different types of existing varieties, state-of-the-art of breeding improvement of kenaf varieties).
- 2. Agronomy of kenaf (soil and climatic requirements, sowing dates, plant densities, nitrogen and irrigation requirements, weed management and diseases).
- 3. Production of kenaf (yielding potential, reported yields in field trials established in the framework of the BioKenaf Network and presentation of the growth simulation model).
- 4. Harvesting and Storage of kenaf (harvesting dates and techniques, storage methods).



Contents of the handbook

- 5. Utilization of kenaf (energy production, fiber production, paper pulp production and other industrial uses).
- 6. Economics (analytical methods, costs of kenaf husbandry, opportunities for reducing production cost, assessment of markets-energy, fiber and paper pulp production-).
- 7. Environmental impact (replacement of conventional fuels with biofuels deriving from kenaf, effects on the quality of water and soil, use of resources, soil erosion, biodiversity).
- 8. Issues that need further investigation in the frame of RTD, at EU level.
