NATIONAL CLIMATE CHANGE STRATEGY

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National Climate Change Strategy

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UNFCCC

- Signature: June 1992 (Rio Summit)
- Ratification: April 1994 (L.2205/1994)
- EU objective : stabilization of 2000 emissions to 1990 level

1st National Climate Change Programme (1995)

- Objective : restriction of the total increase in CO2 emissions during the 1990 – 2000 period to 15% ± 3%
- Abatement measures :
 - Supply side
 - ✓ Introduction of natural gas
 - Modernisation of existing system
 - ✓ Development of CHP generation systems
 - ✓ Large-scale exploitation of renewable energy sources
 - Demand side
 - Introduction of natural gas in the industrial, tertiary and residential sector
 - Energy conservation in buildings and manufacture units
 - Reduction of energy consumption in the transport sector

Inter – ministerial Coordination

- Inter-ministerial Committee on climate change issues – 1996
- Coordinator : Ministry for the Environment

Adoption of Kyoto Protocol

- December 1997, Kyoto, Japan
- Signature by EU and MS: April 1998
- Target for EU and MS: 8% reduction for 2008-2012
- EU burden sharing agreement (June 1998)
 Obligation for Greece: Restriction of the increase of GHG's emissions to 25% for 2008-2012 (compared to 1990 emissions)

National Strategy for Sustainable Development

- Climate Change Abatement
- Reform and diversification of energy offer
 Rational use and conservation of energy
 Measures for the reduction of other greenhouse gases
- ✓ Institutional measures

2nd National Climate Change Programme 2000-2010

- Adoption: May 2002
- Additional policies and measures
 - ✓ Electricity generation
 - ➤Further penetration of RES
 - Operation of natural-gas power plants as base load units
 - Further penetration of CHP plants in the industrial and tertiary sectors

✓ Industry

- Further penetration of natural gas for thermal uses
 Promotion of RES
- Various energy conservation measures

✓ Residential and tertiary sector

- Improvements in the thermal behavior of existing buildings
- Promotion of RES
- Promotion of energy efficient appliances and heating equipment
- Further penetration of natural gas for space heating and cooling (tertiary sector)
- Other energy conservation measures

✓ Transport

- Measures concerning vehicles
- Measures concerning fuels used in transport
- Transport management

✓ Industrial processes sector

Restructuring of the operation of chemical industries

✓ Waste management

Flaring of landfill gas in all managed sites for urban centres > 100,000 inhabitants

✓ Agriculture
 ➢ Manure management systems
 ➢ Organic farming

Result of the implementation of the additional policies and measures : increase of GHG emissions could be restricted to 24.5% by 2010
 Within the Kyoto target
