Important aspects - energy planning


- Sustainable utilisation of resources

Who is the typical energy planner?


- Power utility companies

Phase 2: Decision-making




Local Energy Planning



The energy plan can consist of a description of:

- the current energy system
- the composition of the energy supply sources in the municipality
- statistics on the power generation, transmission and stationary use of energy.
- projected stationary energy demand in the municipality, divided on various energy carriers and user sectors
- future energy solutions for community including substantial changes in energy demand
- monitoring and targeting
